

Winter Driving Safety Tips

1. Carry a shovel or scoop: A low speed slide off of a road where the vehicle is close to the road often leaves the vehicle high centered, that is there's enough snow packed under the frame to either lift the drive wheels off the ground or to reduce the traction. Clearing the snow from beneath the vehicle will off give you the traction to get back on the road and on your way.
2. Carry a bag of kitty litter: Scattering kitty litter on packed snow or ice can provide the traction that you need to get going and it's biodegradable.
3. Always dress for the outdoor conditions, as you might need to walk for help.
4. Carry a charged cell phone.
5. Tell someone where you're going.
