## 1. NG/SG Road Sign Prioritization:

- Find motioned that the edited list of safety signs in the allocated amount of \$1800 be used to purchase signs. Richard Johnson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- 2. Snow Fence Report: Supplies ordered just after the December 4, 2017 GLA Board Meeting. The snow fence installation project in South Glastonbury (SG) is nearing completion. Snow fence installation in North Glastonbury (NG) will commence upon delivery of the materials.
  - What to do with old snow fencing? The consensus was to reuse any sections in good condition, while any scrap is a decision for the Board.
- 3. **Reflectors on Culvert Posts:** Project completion at 50%, with Tim and Richard collaborating.

- 5. **Fall grading, Feathering and Mag. Chloride Progress:** SG road grading completed for the season. Remaining roads are too wet to continue further work in N/S Glastonbury until next spring. Detailed planning scheduled for January committee meeting.

6. New List of Back-up Snowplow Drivers: Claudette compiled this list, including phone numbers. Fred is the primary manager of snowplowing services/drivers.

She suggested snowplowing coordinators/Fred meet to improve communication.

8. Aerial Maps and Snowplow Turnarounds: Booklets handed out by Tim for

snowplow drivers/coordinators. Committee consensus was that drivers turn
