

Nomination materials will be mailed April 2, 2018 and will notify members of these procedures. Nominees must be current on all assessments and not in violation of the Covenants.

Ballots and other election materials will be mailed May 12 and are due back by June 15, 2018 if the member is voting by absentee ballot.

Election Day: June 16, 2018 Emigrant Hall

2. The Court will reserve the issue of when members can pay assessments before voting for parties to submit findings. All other matters are taken under advisement.
3. Counsel shall submit proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law to the Court, both on paper to the Clerk of Court and in electronic form to the Court Administrator on or before April 13, 2018.
