### **1. Weed Spraying**

Ron Liljedahl - member of Park County Weed Board, taught college for 25 years, Licensed Pesticide applicator.

Ron and Gerald drove the roads in South Glastonbury inspected the weeds. Ron reported finding knapweed, thistle, and mullein

### **2. Bid for Capricorn Pavement repair by Chad Standish**

Under \$5100 to patch damaged section 24 ft. X 44 ft. The edges are to be saw-cut and excavated, dampened, bladed, and filled with 3.5 inches of hot asphalt and compacted. He will do one half of the road at time and finish the job in one day. He plans to do the work on Tuesday, August 14 or Thursday, August 16. He will also fill the hole on Capricorn Drive in front of the Kozlik's house for the cost of the asphalt, about one yard of material, estimated at \$120.

**Motion:** Charlene motioned to advise the board to accept the bid of Standish Excavation, Gerald seconded. Voice Vote. Unanimous agreement. **Motion carried.**

**Action Item:** Richard will call Jim from Asphalt Paving Professional Coatings who gave us a previous bid and tell Jim we have another contractor.

**Action Item:** Charlotte will draft work order, and committee members will give input. Road Committee members will observe and detail the roadwork.

**Action Item:** Charlene will inform the board of the committee's recommendation and initiate an email vote to hire Standish Excavation for the NG pavement repairs.
