## **Road Committee Meeting Minutes**

Thursday, May 30, 2019 Liberty Hall North Glastonbury

The meeting was called to order by Ken at 7:02pm. Ken asked for changes or additions to the proposed agenda; there were none.

### 1) Approve May 2 Minutes

The minutes of the May 2 meeting were unanimously approved.

## 2) Spring Maintenance Update

### a) Work Orders Review

Ken prepared a spreadsheet comparing the work proposed by Standish Excavation versus what was included in their invoice for South Glastonbury. The proposal for gravel road maintenance was for a total of \$22,100 and only \$11,245 was invoiced. There is still considerable work to be done on Hercules (gravel, grading and rolling). The proposal for application of MgCl on Arcturus and Hercules was \$4,240 and \$7,279 was invoiced. The difference included \$1,790 of surface preparation and \$1,249 for MgCl in excess of what was proposed.

**Action:** Ken will contact Chad and will attempt to resolve the differences.

#### b) Crack Sealing

Dennis approved the proposal from Wharton Asphalt for \$15,000 for crack sealing of Capricorn and Aries. Karleen emailed the accepted proposal to Wharton and they will contact Dennis when they have scheduled the work.

## c) Road Signs

Dennis will put in the new post with a chevron sign on Hercules (facing uphill) and will install refectors on the uphill side of the other three posts.

**Action:** Dennis will install post, sign and reflectors.

#### d) Mowing

Gerald contacted Joanna Dawson to coordinate a drive-through, but she cannot do it until June.

**Action:** Gerald will conduct a drive-through with Joanna to identify the areas where she can adequately mow.

# e) Weed Control

**Action:** Dennis will contact John Carp to see whether he coordinated with Daniel Peterson for weed cutting. If necessary, Dennis will contact Daniel directly.

# 3) New Items

## a) Gravel Donations

Ken, on behalf of Walter, expressed Walter's suggestion to solicit landowners for gravel donations.

**Action:** Ken and Dennis will compose a letter for the upcoming newsletter soliciting gravel donations.
