## **ELECTION COMM SEPT 9. 2020 MEETING MINUTES**

The meeting began via uberconference @ 11.12 MDST.

Attendance: Andrea S., Charlotte M., Jerry L., committee members, & Donna Lash Anderson, landowner

- 1 Jerry nominated Andrea and Charlotte to the committee and they accepted.
- 2 Election letter-Needs to be modified with internet access information for day of the election. Andrea will work on how to do this and offer Committee chairs & Pres to pre-record their messages.
- 3. Number of candidates for NG = 4, 3 for a two year term & 1 for one year; SG = 5, 3 filling a two year term & 2 for a one year term.
- 4. Forms: Proxy form done. Andrea says no need to send the paid eligibility note to LO's. Included in the ballot mailing will be: a half sheet for multiple lot owners, advising them to vote for each lot separately; a half sheet of request for candidate change notice; an absentee ballot page; candidate bios & names of candidates in the other half of GLA; the instructional cover letter; a proxy form; a return envelope with a lot no. & name sticker on it; and a privacy envelope
- 5. Re legal entity: The representative will be named & highlighted on the sign in sheet, as well as those in arrears in assessments, or covenant violations.
- 6. Sign in sheets-AJS will prepare with assistance from John M. & Karleen print and prepare sign in binders.
- 7. Mailing in October. Yes, Charlotte confirmed she will do the collating and mailing on October 5.
- 8. Quorum determined by both mail-in and in person ballots determined by an election official so that the meeting may be opened and ensue. The Pres can announce quorum and official meeting opening via on-line. Mail in, fax & email ballots can be accepted till 5 pm MST on Friday Nov. 13. Walk in ballots are accepted between 10 am & noon on the Nov 14.
- 9. Live, on-line meeting via Zoom or Uberconference will be arranged by Andrea. It may be that this will be started prior to the quorum announcement while ballot envelopes are being counted.
- 10. Training volunteers: Need 4 verifiers, 2 NG, 2 SG, to alphabetize envelopes and give to the sign-in staff. The eligible envelopes go back to the verifiers who will open, 1 at a time, and take the privacy envelopes to the counters. Sign-in staff 2 NG, 2 SG, mark eligibility status, (ask an in person registrant to sign the sign-in sheet.) The counters, 2 NG, 2 SG, can begin counting prior to close of voting. A verifier can then be an observer to oversee the counting & prevent interference.

Sign-in training: Nov 10; Counters Nov 11; Verifiers Nov 12.

- 11. candidates and bios will be posted on the website.
- 12. Volunteers. Jerry will do. Some are already available. Charlotte said she will be an election official as will Jerry.
- 13. Timeline discussed. A packet of forms for all will be sent to the BOD for email approval, date TBD.
