2026 PROPOSED BYLAW REVISIONS

Dear Glastonbury Landowners,

The Glastonbury Board of Directors (GLA) Governing Documents Committee has undertaken a review of the GLA Bylaws and is proposing language to amend the Bylaws in seven topic areas. The Board respectfully requests Landowners review the proposed changes and provide comments by August 1, 2026.

The proposed changes to the Bylaws would amend language in the following areas:

- Conflict of Interest, Code of Conduct requirements for Directors, and Road Policy
- Complaints and Compliance Process
- Capital Expenditures
- Removal of Directors from the Board
- Closed Meetings
- Equal Representation on the Board
- Election process
 - Candidates with unpaid assessments, fees, and penalties
 - Landowners with unpaid assessments, fees, and penalties
 - Candidate Governing Document violations
 - Candidate biographies
 - Number of votes required to be seated on the Board

In an effort to save on ***significant mailing costs***, the Board will not be mailing paper copies of the proposed changes.
